## **5K - PREMATURE VENTRICULAR CONTRACTIONS ADULT & PEDIATRIC**

#### TREATMENT PRIORITIES

1. O2 via NC or NRB if indicated 2. 12-Lead ECG

#### 3. Rhythm Analysis

#### UNSTABLE (SYMPTOMATIC) premature ventricular contractions are defined by any of the following symptoms:

- 1. Dyspnea
- 2. Chest pain
- 3. Weakness Altered mental status 4.
- Hypoxemia
- 5. 6. Pulmonary edema

### PARAMEDIC

ASYMPTOMATIC PVCs DO NOT REQUIRE ANTI-DYSRHYTHMIC MEDICATION.

TREAT IF UNSTABLE WITH SYMPTOMS AND ADULT SYS BP < 100 mmHg

DO NOT PHARMACOLOGICALLY SUPPRESS PVCs IN 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> DEGREE HEART BLOCKS ADULT: AMIODARONE 150mg VERY SLOW IVP/IVPB OVER 10 MINUTES.

PEDIATRIC: OLMC CONSULT
