Sooner Road, Oklahoma City, OK 73135 and 1417 N. Lansing Avenue, Tulsa, OK 74106, linked via videoconference.

1. **Roll Call** indicated a quorum was not present and the meeting was called to order at 09:05 am by Dr. Russell Anderson.

2. **Review and Approval of May 2026 MCB Meeting Minutes**

A motion was unable to be made and seconded to approve the minutes of the May 2026 MCB Meeting. This action will be forwarded to the September 2026 meeting.

3. **Oklahoma City Fire Department Report – Chief Richard Kelley**

EMS Chief Carl Cobb share ongoing training is in process for all EMS personnel. EMS Transport Supervisors moving to 24 hrs shifts on July 3rd.

4. **Tulsa Fire Department Report – Chief Michael Baker**

EMS Officer Robert Brown shared that Tulsa Fire is working with Pulsara and also has plans for obtaining EleGard.

5. **EMSA President Report – Johna Easley**

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EMSA's COO Tom Dunn shared that a new professional development specialist is hired for leadership development and for clinical staff as well. Divert, destination, and response time compliance reports were supplied to MCB members from the EMSA executive team.

6. Chief Medical Officer/Associate Chief Medical Officer Reports

Dr. Goodloe updated the MCB on activities completed by the OMD team in the interim since the May 2026 MCB meeting.

Dr. Goodloe briefly highlighted the numerous meetings that the OMD team continues to have with agencies within the EMS system, including orientation academies as well as the long-established monthly CQI meetings led by OMD.

Dr. Goodloe updated the MCB on implementation plans for the third-generation head-up CPR device, the EleGARD 3.0, now available for production on order as reported to the MCB at its March meeting.

Dr. Goodloe updated the MCB on the last 2 months (March and April 2026) analysis of 911 BLS response within EMSA. 19.3% of eligible BLS ambulance calls were answered by BLS ambulances, meaning the remaining 80.7% were answered by a paramedic-staffed ambulance. The typical three parameters are within MCB/OMD goals: use of RLS return 0.6% (less than 1%); ALS assist 2.3% (less than 10%); and unstable VS as defined by MCB protocols 1.6% (less than 3%).

7. Review and Approval of Medical Priority Dispatch System Determinant Codes Updates

Dr. Goodloe presented the MPDS determinant codes updates to further refine call prioritization and response matrix assignments.

A motion was unable to be made and seconded that the MCB approve the recommended updates to the MPDS determinant codes. This action will be forwarded to the September 2026 meeting.

8. Review and Approval of MCB Treatment Protocols

Dr. Goodloe presented the recommendation to include methylprednisolone, dermal nitroglycerin, and adding acetaminophen intravenous to the Advanced EMT scope of practice for the included protocols above. Dr. Goodloe also recommended updates to the Categorization of Hospitals Table, including the addition of a surgical specialty hospital in OKC, OneCore Health.

A motion was unable to be made and seconded that the MCB approve the recommended protocol changes as above. This action will be forwarded to the September 2026 meeting.

9. Review and Approval of April 2026 and May 2026 MCB Financial Statements

Dr. Goodloe presented the financial statement to the MCB, discussing revenue and expenses for the tenth and eleventh months of FY 2025-2026.

A motion was unable to be made and seconded that the MCB approve the April 2026 and May 2026 MCB Financial Statements. This action will be forwarded to the September 2026 meeting.
