3. Oklahoma City Fire Department Report – Chief Richard Kelley

Lori Brown-Loftis updated the MCB that OKCFD MIH will be starting a pilot program at the main Embark Transit Station with MIH paramedics to triage out chronic wound care and other types of calls that could preclude clinically unnecessary 911 response. The pilot program will be starting on May 21st.

4. Tulsa Fire Department Report – Chief Michael Baker

Justin Lemery discussed the launch of the ART3 team in TFD MIH for mental health crisis response and case management with follow-ups. ART2 operates on the north side of Tulsa. There is also funding approval for a class of up to twenty paramedics to be trained at Tulsa Technical College. The ART teams will also have access to point of care testing soon, starting with a metabolic panel and will see how this may augment current clinical assessments.

5. EMSA President Report – Johna Easley

No report was given from EMSA at this meeting. Divert, destination, and response time compliance reports were supplied to MCB members from the EMSA executive team.

6. Chief Medical Officer/Associate Chief Medical Officer Reports

Dr. Goodloe updated the MCB on activities completed by the OMD team in the interim since the March 2026 MCB meeting.

Dr. Goodloe briefly highlighted the numerous meetings that the OMD team continues to have with agencies within the EMS system, including orientation academies as well as the long-established monthly CQI meetings led by OMD.

Dr. Goodloe updated the MCB on implementation plans for the third-generation head-up CPR device, the EleGARD 3.0, now available for production on order as reported to the MCB at its March meeting.

Dr. Goodloe updated the MCB on the last 2 months (March and April 2026) analysis of 911 BLS response within EMSA. 24.1% of eligible BLS ambulance calls were answered by BLS ambulances, meaning the remaining 75.9% were answered by a paramedic-staffed ambulance. The typical three parameters are within MCB/OMD goals: use of RLS return

0.7% (less than 1%); ALS assist 1.3% (less than 10%); and unstable VS as defined by MCB protocols 1.2% (less than 3%).

Matt Cox updated the MCB physicians on EMS system cardiac arrest resuscitation outcomes for CY2025, specifically citing Utstein survival of 42% with 100% CPC1! This equates with an all-time EMS system's high performance.

7. Review and Approval of MCB FY26-27 Budget

Dr. Goodloe presented the annual MCB budget for the coming FY 26-27, discussing anticipated revenue and expenses. He will be presenting this to the City Councils for Oklahoma City and Tulsa asap following this MCB meeting.
